

Sample Q-Social-Sensing Data Service Repository User Agreement

This User Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is entered into on the Users date of registration on the Q-Social-Sensing (QSS) website, and is made by and between the User and Qatar Computing Research Institute (hereinafter referred to as "QCRI"), a center of Qatar Foundation for Education, Science and Community Development (hereinafter referred to as "QF").

Introduction to QSS

QCRI has created a platform to collect social media data, primarily for research in humanitarian computing. Data is collected from publicly available sources, and using publicly available application programming interfaces (APIs). Researchers using these datasets often find that their collection can be used for purposes beyond what they anticipated, and choose to share it with other researchers. These collections consist of Tweet-IDs and may include additional information added by QCRI (e.g. categorical labels for some meta data items).


To enable this sharing of data collections across researchers, QCRI has developed the Q-Social-Sensing (QSS) data repository, available at http://qss.qcri.org. It is a free service that allows the download of data collections created by other researchers who chose to make it public. By agreeing to download a dataset, you are implicitly agreeing to acknowledge QCRI in any publications resulting from the data, and to provide QCRI a copy of any paper, published or unpublished, created based on the use of this data. It is important to note that any data either downloaded from QSS must be used only for non-profit, non-commercial purposes.

Terms and Conditions of this User Agreement

PLEASE READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY. As a User of QSS, you agree to be bound by the terms in this Agreement. By accepting the terms at account registration, the User unconditionally agrees to ALL of these terms, conditions and polices contained herein.

QCRI at its sole discretion may update these terms, conditions and polices from time to time by posting them on the website. QCRI will provide a 45-day written notice to registered Users by email only of any planned and upcoming revisions or modifications to this Agreement. 

DEFINITIONS

The following capitalized terms have the following meaning set forth below.

"Personal Data" is registration data that can identify a registered User of the website




QSS USER SAMPLE DATA SET DOWNLOAD RULES AND PERMISSIONS

<u>Twitter Development Policy Compliance Requirement</u>

For QSS website to be in compliance with Twitter Developer Policy, https://dev.twitter.com/overview/terms/policy, the sample datasets found on QSS website are limited to a maximum of 50,000 public tweet IDs and the QSS website will provide code snippet to download twitter JSON from twitter. The QSS website will limit a User's maximum daily download accordingly.


The privacy policy statement applicable to QSS:

QSS website uses your Facebook, Twitter or Google credentials for login.




QF/QCRI retain the right to discontinue the Service at any time. In such case an email will be sent to Users giving a notice period.


